Overview of CORE Grant Management Unit

CORE is an administrative/grant management unit that provides support for faculty research in the College of Education. Professional staff at CORE provide proposal development, human resources, administrative and fiscal support to faculty and staff housed across 10 research/outreach centers. These services are provided by Officers of Administration or classified employees who work under the supervision of a faculty Director. There is only one member of the United Academics faculty union who is an employee of CORE.
